

A THIRD-PARTY AUDIT IS PERFORMED BY A CERTIFYING BODY THAT'S INDEPENDENT OF THE CUSTOMER-SUPPLIER (OR RETAILER-SUPPLIER) RELATIONSHIP. AUDITS CAN BE FOR GENERAL FOOD SAFETY, AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES, EMPLOYEE WELFARE, ANIMAL WÉLFARE, OR FOR CERTIFICATIONS LIKE ORGANIC OR KOSHER, AND OTHERS. THE DIFFERENT CERTIFICATIONS MAY VARY IN THEIR APPROACH, BUT HERE ARE

4 KEY STEPS.

FLANNING

LONG BEFORE ANY ON-SITE INSPECTION, THE FOOD PRODUCER (OR HANDLER) **MUST REVIEW THE** STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS THEY ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOW.

A TRAINED INSPECTOR IS GIVEN A COMPREHENSIVE **GUIDE OF THE STANDARDS** THEY ARE AUDITING TO.

ALSO BEFORE THE ON-SITE VISIT, THE PRODUCER HANDS **OVER ANY RELEVANT** INFORMATION ABOUT THEIR PLANS, PRACTICES AND SYSTEMS.




ORGANIC CERTIFICATION HAS AN ADDITIONAL STEP WHERE AN OPERATION'S ORGANIC SYSTEM NEEDS TO BE OFFICIALLY REVIEWED BEFORE SCHEDULING THE INSPECTION.

CERTIFIERS SEND QUALIFIED **INSPECTORS TO PERFORM** AN ANNOUNCED OR UNANNOUNCED, TOP-TO-BOTTOM ON-SITE INSPECTION.

DIFFERENT CERTIFICATIONS

THE INDEPENDENT

WILL EMPHASIZE DIFFERENT **AREAS, BUT MOST** INSPECTIONS INCLUDE A THOROUGH REVIEW OF THE **NECESSARY RECORDS AS** WELL.

CERTIFYING AGENT FOR REVIEW AND ASSESSMENT. SOME RESULTS, SUCH AS FOOD SAFETY AUDITS, ARE DETERMINED AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION.

IN SOME INSTANCES, THE CERTIFYING BODY WOULD NOW PRESENT THE RESULTS TO THE FOOD PRODUCER OR

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HANDLER. IN OTHER CASES, THE AUDITOR SIMPLY GATHERS

INFORMATION AND TAKES PHOTOS, AND THEN UPLOADS THEIR FINDINGS FOR REVIEW. THE DETERMINATION IS THEN EITHER MADE BY THE AUDITING COMPANY OR A REVIEWER ON THEIR BEHALF. THIS EXTRA STEP IS USEFUL TO MINIMIZE

POSSIBLE AUDITOR BIAS. DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF CERTIFICATION SOUGHT AND THE INSPECTION'S FINDINGS, THIRD-PARTY AUDITS CAN RESULT IN CERTIFICATION, REGISTRATION, RECOGNITION,

AN AWARD, LICENSE APPRÓVAL, OR OTHER DESIGNATIONS.







OTHER AUDITS, SUCH AS THE AUDITS OF EGG FARMS, ARE REVIEWED AND EITHER A CERTIFICATION IS ISSUED, OR CORRECTIVE ACTIONS ARE ASSIGNED THAT MUST BE

COMPLETED BEFORE A CERTIFICATION IS ISSUED.
