



# JONES FARM ORGANICS GROWING PRACTICES

THE JONES' ROBUST CROP ROTATION INCORPORATES REGENERATIVE PRACTICES LIKE COVER CROPPING AND STRATEGIC ANIMAL INTEGRATION TO BUILD SOIL HEALTH AND IMPROVE BIODIVERSITY.

## ROTATIONAL GRAZING OF COWS

COWS ARE BROUGHT IN FROM NEIGHBORING FARMS TO GRAZE ON THE LAND PERIODICALLY. THIS ALLOWS THE GRASS AND WEEDS TO BE "MOWED" BY THE COWS, ASSISTING NEW NUTRIENT REGROWTH. THIS HELPS CYCLE THE CARBON AND OXYGEN, RESULTING IN CARBON SEQUESTRATION AND MORE NUTRIENT DENSE SOIL.

## ORGANIC POTATOES

COMPOST AND CONSTANT WATER CONTENT OBSERVATION HELP COMPLEMENT THEIR GROWTH, ALONG WITH THE NUTRIENTS THAT ARE GROWN AND DEPOSITED DURING THE OTHER PARTS OF THE CYCLE.

## COVER CROPS/WHEAT

WHEAT IS GROWN IN BETWEEN THE HARVESTING AND PLANTING OF POTATOES. THESE GRAINS ARE GROWN FOR A VARIETY OF LOCAL SUPPLIERS AND AID IN BOTH FINANCES AND SOIL HEALTH. BY GROWING A VARIETY OF CROPS, THE JONES ALSO AVOID THE PITFALL OF DRAINING THE SOIL DRY OF NUTRIENTS FROM MONO CROPPING.
